REPORT ON THE STATUS OF THE BUSINESS RESCUE PROCEEDINGS OF TONGAAT HULETT DEVELOPMENTS PROPRIETARY LIMITED (IN BUSINESS RESCUE) ("Company")

1. GENERAL

- 1.1. In accordance with section 132(3)(a) and section 132(3)(b) of the Companies Act 71 of 2008, as amended ("Act") when the business rescue proceedings of a company have not concluded within 3 months of the date on which they started, a business rescue practitioner is required to-
 - 1.1.1. prepare a report on the progress of the business rescue, and update it at the end of each subsequent month until the end of the business rescue proceedings; and
 - 1.1.2. deliver the report and each update to each affected person and to the Companies and Intellectual Property Commission ("**CIPC**").
- 1.2. Accordingly, we hereby provide you with the fourth report, being the April 2023 report, on the status of the Company's business rescue proceedings.
- 1.3. The following matters have occurred or remain relevant since the distribution and publication of the March 2023 status update report:

2. BUSINESS RESCUE UPDATES

- 2.1. <u>Business Rescue Plan Publication</u> The current date by when the Plan is required to be published is on or before **21 May 2023**.
- 2.2. <u>Asset and Business Sales</u> We continue to investigate various sales processes related to the assets of the Company which are available to realise potential value for the Company's Affected Persons. These potential disposals will be dealt with in greater detail in the Company's Plan. Our investigations include considerations relating to properties and/or shareholdings, projects/claims and movable assets that may be disposed of.
- 2.3. <u>Business Rescue Proceedings of other Tongaat Hulett group entities</u> The business rescue plan for Tongaat Hulett Limited ("THL"), the Company's ultimate parent company, is intended to be published on or before 31 May 2023 and the business rescue plans for the other two Tongaat Hulett group companies in business rescue, Tongaat Hulett Sugar South Africa Limited ("THSSA") and Voermol Feeds Proprietary Limited ("Voermol") are expected to be published on or before 31 May 2023.

Separate monthly status update reports are provided for THL, THSSA and Voermol, which reports are uploaded and made accessible to Affected Persons on the Company's website at: <u>www.tongaat.com</u>, under the 'Business Rescue' tab.

- 2.4. <u>Rule Nisi re. Perfection of General Notarial Bonds</u> Affected Persons are reminded of the institution of an application to Court, by the Tongaat Hulett lenders, to perfect the general notarial bonds registered in favour of the lenders, and the subsequent *Rule Nisi* date arising from the High Court of South Africa, Kwa-Zulu Natal Division's ("**High Court**") order inviting any interested party to appear before the High Court to show cause why an order on the terms provided for in the *Rule Nisi*, should not be made final (accessible to Affected Persons on the Company's website at: <u>www.tongaat.com</u>, under the 'Business Rescue' tab). In this regard, Affected Parties are reminded that the High Court extended the *Rule Nisi* date to 16 May 2023.
- 2.5. <u>Claims Reconciliation</u> We continue to receive claim forms from multiple creditors. The process of claims verification, whereby we reconcile the claims of creditors as reflected in the records of the Company against the claim forms received, remains ongoing. We will accept the Company records as being correct unless the claimant can prove otherwise. Creditors who have not submitted a claim form and are intending to are urged to do so as soon as possible before the publication of the Plan. Claims may be submitted to the BRPs at the business rescue email address at: <u>BR@tongaat.com</u>. All claims that are accepted in whole or in part will be reflected in the Plan. Other than that which is disclosed in the Plan, or in the case of disputed claims, no



other direct communication will be provided to creditors about whether a claim has been accepted or not. The Plan will provide a process for creditors to deal with any disputes related to claims and creditors with disputed claims will be at liberty to follow such process, if they so wish.

2.6. <u>Other Litigation Matters</u> – Affected Persons are advised that an important Notice to Affected Persons and other information pertaining to an ongoing litigation matter within the Tongaat Hulett group, will be distributed to Affected Persons during the week commencing 01 May 2023.

3. CLOSING REMARKS

- 3.1. It remains our view that with your continued assistance and co-operation, the Company stands a reasonable chance of being rescued, within the meaning of section 128(1)(h) of the Companies Act, in a manner that will balance the rights and interests of all Affected Persons.
- 3.2. Affected Persons are reminded that all notices and documents regarding the business rescue proceedings of the Company that have been and/or will be circulated to all known Affected Persons, are/will be published and made available to all Affected Persons, on the Tongaat website at: <u>https://www.tongaat.com</u>, under the 'Business Rescue' tab.
