REPORT ON THE STATUS OF THE BUSINESS RESCUE PROCEEDINGS OF TONGAAT-HULETT LIMITED (IN BUSINESS RESCUE)

GENERAL

- 1 Section 132(3)(a) and section 132(3)(b) of the Companies Act 71 of 2008 (as amended) (the "**Companies Act**") stipulate that when the business rescue proceedings of a company have not concluded within three months of the date on which they commenced, a business rescue practitioner is required to:
 - 1.1 prepare a report on the progress of the business rescue proceedings, and update it at the end of each subsequent month until the end of those proceedings; and
 - 1.2 deliver the report and each update to each Affected Person and to the Companies and Intellectual Property Commission (the "**CIPC**").
- 2 This report is the 43rd report prepared in accordance with section 132(3) of the Companies Act.

BUSINESS RESCUE UPDATES

- 3 In February 2026, the BRPs instituted an application in the KwaZulu-Natal Division of the High Court of South Africa under case number 2026-031780 (the "**Liquidation proceedings**") in terms of section 141(2) of the Companies Act 71 of 2008 in terms of which THL and the BRPs applied for an order, *inter alia*, that THL's business rescue proceedings be discontinued and that THL be placed into provisional winding-up.

- 4 The Liquidation Proceedings were withdrawn on 17 June 2026, since which the following matters have occurred and/or remain relevant since the distribution and publication of THL's June 2026 business rescue status update report (the "**June Report**"):
 - 4.1 THL continues to operate in a materially constrained commercial environment. Structural market pressures, import dynamics, customer hesitancy, and supply-side constraints continue to impact revenue generation and cash flow.
 - 4.2 Continued sugar imports into the South African market, driven by low tariff protection, have displaced locally produced sugar from the domestic market. The ITAC review of the dollar-based preference price underpinning the tariffs remains ongoing;
 - 4.3 THL continues to operate under the Post Commencement Finance ("**PCF**") Amending Agreement 12 ("**PCF 12**") provided by the IDC, which was extended to 30 September 2026. The most recent extension, PCF 12, includes the following key terms:
 - 4.3.1 the PCF Facility, in the amount of R2.5 billion, remains available until 30 September 2026, or earlier upon the granting of an order terminating the Company's business rescue proceedings and winding up the Company or the setting aside of the adopted business rescue plan;
 - 4.3.2 the PCF Facility remains secured under the existing security package granted by the Company in favour of the IDC, which security remains in full force and effect; and
 - 4.3.3 all amounts outstanding under the PCF Facility must be repaid in full, or may, at the IDC's discretion, be restructured into a term loan on terms and conditions acceptable to the IDC, prior to any sale or transfer of the Company's business and assets as a going concern in accordance with the approved or proposed business rescue plan.
 - 4.4 The Post Commencement Finance Facility provided by the IDC remains in place until 30 September 2026 and continues to provide support for the Company's working capital requirements and ongoing operations. Headroom remains under pressure from the challenging commercial conditions identified above. The facility remains subject to tight controls over payments and drawdowns implemented by the IDC. Engagements with the IDC regarding future funding requirements remain ongoing.

BUSINESS RESCUE PROCEEDINGS OF OTHER TONGAAT HULETT GROUP ENTITIES

- 5 The business rescue plan for Tongaat Hulett Developments Proprietary Limited ("**THD**"), as approved and adopted by the relevant affected persons on 30 May 2023, continues to be implemented.
- 6 THD's business rescue plan is separate and distinct from that of THL and is expected to continue unaffected following the withdrawal of the Liquidation Proceedings.
- 7 Separate monthly status update reports are provided for THD, Tongaat Hulett Sugar South Africa (Pty) Ltd ("**THSSA**"), and Voermol Feeds (Pty) Ltd ("**Voermol**"). These reports are

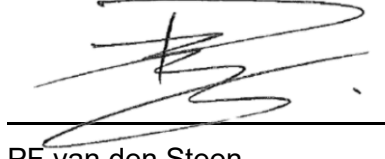
LITIGATION MATTERS

- 8 The application for leave to appeal to the Constitutional Court in respect of the Declaratory Proceeding remains pending.
- 9 The Liquidation Proceedings were withdrawn on 17 June 2026.
- 10 The counter application by RGS to have the Business Rescue Plan set aside and to compel Vision to disclose certain documents was heard on 18 June 2026. 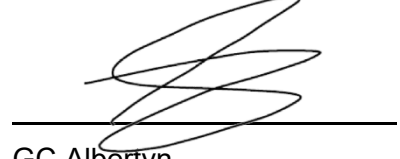
